Finally, the last Thursday in February CHK's Steve Sorenson taught most unusual facts about Lincoln.



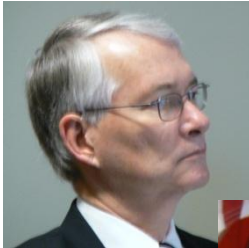

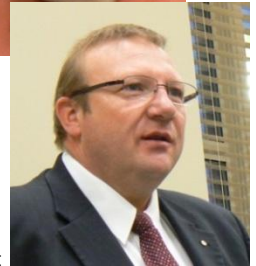

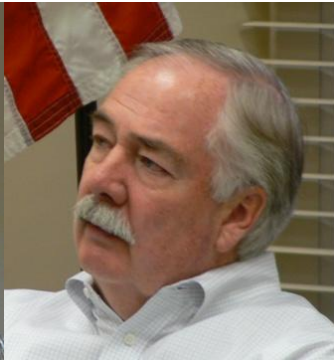
