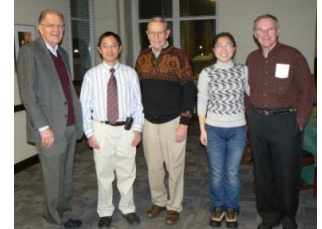


Amy Wylie

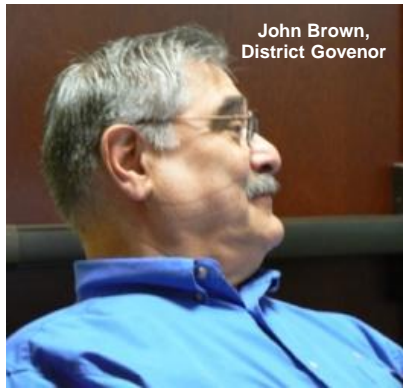
## Christmas Social Closes 2009

The catered dinner kicked off an appetizing Christmas social for Kiwanians on December 10. ↘



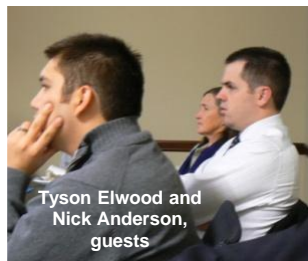

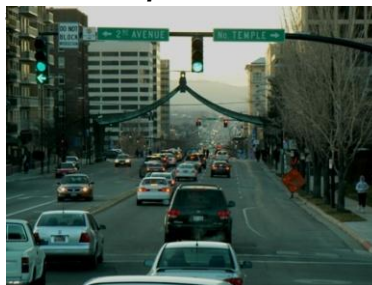
